

Te Rūnanga o NgāiTakoto Trustee Elections 2026

Criminal history check

A guide for candidates nominating for the 2026 Trustee election

Note for candidates: As part of the eligibility process, all candidates are required to undergo a criminal history check. Te Rūnanga o NgāiTakoto will submit this check to the Ministry of Justice on your behalf — you do not need to do this yourself. You will need to provide some personal details and two forms of ID.

WHAT TO EXPECT

1

Complete your details

Fill in the required personal information as part of your nomination pack and return it to TRoNT.

2

Provide two forms of ID

One must be a photo ID. See the lists below for accepted documents.

3

TRoNT submits the check

We submit the request to the Ministry of Justice on your behalf.

4

Result is reviewed

Results are reviewed by TRoNT as part of the election eligibility process and are treated confidentially.

ACCEPTED ID DOCUMENTS

SECONDARY ID — CHOOSE ONE

- NZ or overseas passport
- NZ full birth certificate (issued 1998 or later)
- NZ firearms licence
- NZ refugee travel document
- NZ certificate of identity
- NZ citizen certificate

- NZ driver licence
- IRD number confirmation
- Kiwi Access (18+) card
- NZ utility bill (issued within 6 months)
- NZ birth certificate (issued before 1998)
- Community services card
- NZ electoral roll record
- SuperGold card
- NZ employee photo ID card

Documents expired within the last 5 years may be accepted. If you cannot provide all required IDs, supply as many forms as you can and contact us — we will help you find a solution.

PERSONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED

EVERYONE MUST PROVIDE

- Full legal name
- Date of birth
- Country and place of birth
- Current address
- Email address
- Any previous names used

ALSO PROVIDE IF APPLICABLE

- Previous addresses (if at current address less than 10 years)
- Whether you have ever lived in Australia
